What is this event?

The event is being held to launch the Adult Carers' Action Plan. If you are a carer of somebody aged 18 or older we invite you to join us. You will be able to ask questions at the event and bring information to share. We want you to have a voice, your views and ideas are important to us. You really can have an influence and make a difference.

What is the Adult Carers' Action Plan?

Sheffield has a strategy which sets out how carers who care for someone living in Sheffield will be supported. When Sheffield City Council talked to carers to understand what the strategy should include, the message from carers was clear. Carers did not want another glossy document that did not have an impact on their lives. To make sure carers can see how things are changing for the better as a result of the Carers' Strategy, an action plan was included in the document.

What is happening now?

The Council and partners are developing the Adult Carers' Action Plan that is in the Strategy. This has created a more detailed list of actions that will be added to on an ongoing basis. Carers can now see what organisations like Sheffield Teaching Hospitals, Sheffield Clinical Commissioning Group and Sheffield City Council are specifically doing to help them. These actions will be reviewed every 6 months with carers to make sure we continue to change things in the way that carers want.
