- **SOGB comment** – Accessible access to the powerlifting is via the main school entrance rather than the side entrance for general spectators. Volunteers at the welcome desk will be on hand to escort. Access to the cycle track is via the lift inside the sports centre adjacent to the stair case. Access is then via a trackway walkway to the side of the field of play. This trackway may be difficult for some motorised accessible vehicles so please ask a volunteer for assistance if necessary.

- **SOGB comment** – The entry from Stadium Way is a steep slope – volunteers are on hand to assist. The viewing from the grandstand has accessible spaces at the back and the front. Other viewing is on chairs and rugs on the grass slopes. Access to the toilets is either in front of the clubhouse to the temporary facilities or up the slope and to the back of the clubhouse for the existing accessible toilet. Please give yourself time to get around and ask for help as required.

- **SOGB comment** – Accessible viewing is available from the picnic area. Part of the picnic area is on a slope and grassed so please ask for assistance from volunteers depending on accessible needs.

If you're really keen to attend a venue for an event not on the list above, here's some further information.

All Saints (for Basketball and Netball) – seating is integrated with the general seating on Tuesday – Thursday. On Friday there will be accessible seating to the side of the pull out seating.

Doncaster (for Indoor Bowls) – all integrated with the general spectator seating in the café.

Graves (for Short Mat Bowls and Tennis) – seating next to the temporary grandstands is extensive and carer seats are available. There is a lift between the accessible seating and the accessible toilets. This may need to be factored in for time.

Parklands (for the Equestrian competition) – accessible viewing for the dressage and prix caprilli is only accessed by the side of the stables. Please ask at the reception desk as you will need to be escorted. Accessible viewing for the working trials arena is fully integrated with the rest of the public who have standing only areas. Accessible toilet facilities are in a portable unit.

Ponds Forge (for Aquatics and Boccia) – seating is identified within the existing grandstands. Ask stewards for assistance if not obvious. For the Boccia, all viewing is from the balcony, some areas have higher barriers so please ask the stewards for assistance in finding a location with lower barriers as required.

Rother Valley (for Golf) – Access to the first tee and 18 hole is fully accessible – it will be quicker to go round the left of the clubhouse to access this – access is available through the clubhouse but could take longer. Access around the course is on grass and limited to 3 people per player.
