Catherine has a learning disability and is the lead trainer at CHANGE and Ana is a Project Worker at CHANGE.



CHANGE was the first organisation to employ people with learning disabilities on a co-working model.



Co-working is where a person with a learning disability co-works on the same project getting paid the same pay and working the same days as their non-disabled co-worker.



CHANGE was also the first organisation to make easy read for people with learning disabilities.

We are doing a research project creating Peer support worker roles for people with learning disabilities in care organisations.



This will end with people with learning disabilities being employed as peer support workers.

Do you know of any stories of where people with learning disabilities have been employed in skilled jobs?


