WHY SINGLE PARENT MUMS?

Volunteers from the Women's Hub are raising awareness about the specific effects of austerity and wage poverty on single parent women.

This is about fairness and equality. There is evidence that single mums are more likely to experience poverty than other groups. Some single mums, for example BAMER and disabled women, will face additional disadvantage.

We want to get a handle on how financial pressures build up. We are trying to capture things which are more difficult to talk about and measure; What's it like for women who have no rights to work or financial support? What are the pressures of family expectations? How are unexpected events paid for? How do women "get by" without turning to crime or risky activity? What about hidden debt?

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

We are trying to start conversations about what it's really like for women. We hope to influence decisions about delivering services that might make a difference.

We want to highlight possible solutions, find out what has been helpful, and what can be learned to support other women in a sustainable way.

We will report on findings at an event organised with single parent mums.
