How to find Moorfoot

The Moorfoot building (formerly Manpower Services) is located at the foot of the Moor, with the main entrance in a direct line with the street. The easiest way to find Moorfoot is to walk down the Moor, cross the road at the bottom and keep walking between the buildings until you see the entrance. The approximate location of the entrance is marked on the image below.

For people coming into the city from outside, it is approximately 20 minutes walk from Sheffield Station.

Parking

The car park at Moorfoot is restricted to special requirements at the moment. If you require a disabled parking space please contact moorfootlearning@sheffield.gov.uk

The nearest public car park is the APCOA car park on Eyre Street, Atkinsons or there's a charity car park at the back of Decathlon Sports on Sylvester Street.

You can also find secure cycle stands available for up to 20 cycles and stands for mopeds and motorbikes on the right hand side of the building's car park. These are available on a first come first served basis.

How to get to the Moorfoot Learning Centre

Go to the main reception desk (to the right of the main entrance) and sign in the Moorfoot Learning Centre book, after which you will be directed to the Centre which is located on Floor 1.

The Moorfoot Learning Centre Reception staff will then direct you to the relevant training room(s), **Please note there is a restaurant on Floor 2 to buy food/refreshments etc.**

At the end of your training course, please sign out at main reception on leaving the building.

Refreshments

There will be regular breaks during the training but we will be unable to provide food or drinks:

You can buy drinks and food from Flavours Café on Floor 2 of the Moorfoot Building



You can buy drinks and food from the local shops on the Moorfoot and eat them either on the Moor Precinct or in Flavours Café

You can bring your own food and drink; you are also welcome to eat this in Flavours Café with other learners.

Any packed lunch you bring can be stored in the fridge at the Moorfoot Learning Centre.

Food should not be eaten in the training rooms. Drinks may be brought into the rooms but we ask learners to use the recycle bins provided in the training rooms.
