For your time, refreshments and a light lunch or dinner will be provided, and as a thank you, you will also receive a £30 high-street shopping voucher (at the end of the workshop).

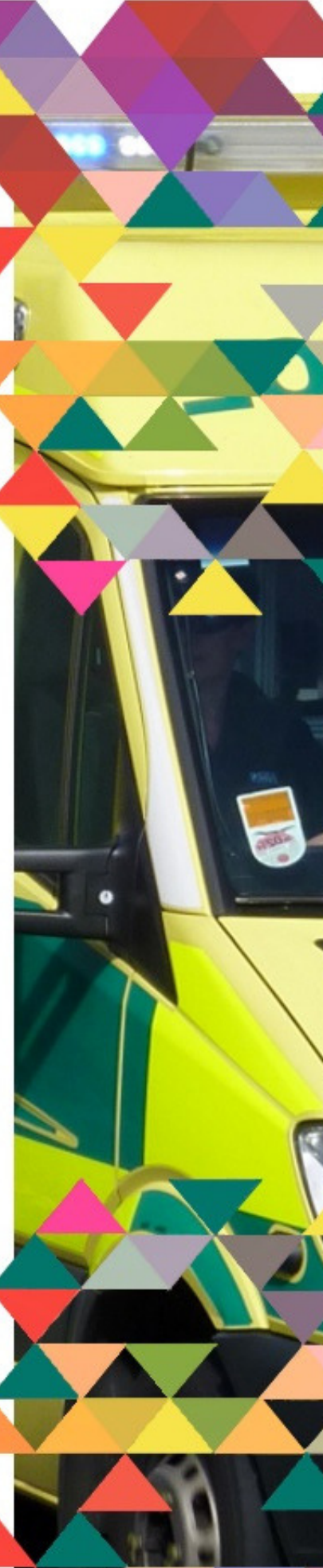
